

SLUDGE. WHAT IS IT?

Sludge is the number 1 cause of boiler breakdowns. It forms when corrosion builds up inside your home's heating system, causing inconvenient failures and expensive repairs.

Boilers damaged or failed due to sludge are NOT covered under the boiler warranty.

Why?

Boiler manufacturers have no control over the quality of your system water, but they do understand the risks of sludge circulating around the system and have therefore added advisory information in their manuals on how to protect and prolong the life of the boiler. Some have even added clauses if the boiler fails and the system water quality is proved to be poor/neglected.

Remember, a boiler is only as efficient as the water that is passing through it.

It's a bit like adding and maintaining an oil filter for your car – protect your investment!
